

Advisory Committees

The Board encourages the participation of citizens of the district in decision making processes. However, the legal responsibility for decision making in all matters of policy and operation rests with the Board.

Appointments of citizens to advisory committees shall be approved by the Board. An advisory committee member may be removed from office by the Board if he or she does not attend three consecutive meetings.

1. Board-Appointed Advisory Committees/Commissions. The Board may appoint advisory committees/commissions from time to time if found necessary or desirable. The Board will direct the superintendent to determine the method to be used for its appointment of advisory committees/commissions. Such committees/commissions, under the direction of the superintendent or designee, make thorough studies of the subjects assigned to them, and submit their findings and recommendations to the Board through the superintendent.
2. District Advisory Accountability Committee. The Board shall appoint a District Advisory Accountability Committee which shall make recommendations to the Board relative to the program of accountability.
3. Advisory School District Personnel Performance Evaluation Council. The Board shall appoint an advisory district personnel performance evaluation council which shall perform such duties as are required by law or designated by the Board and which shall, at a minimum, consist of one teacher, one administrator, one principal, one parent of a child enrolled in the district, and one patron (person who does not have a child in school).
4. Community Groups. Community groups that are neither appointed by the Board nor formed as required under federal or state programs are encouraged to offer suggestions and advice to the Board in order to assist it in the decision making process. The final responsibility for all decisions, however, rests with the Board of Education alone.
