

School Year/School Calendar

The Board shall adopt a school calendar annually not later than June 1 for the succeeding school year. The Board shall consider recommendations from the superintendent based upon input from the district staff and community.

The number of days of planned teacher-student instruction and of teacher-student contact shall meet or exceed the requirements of state law.

The superintendent shall recommend the calendar to the Board no later than the first board meeting in April.

The Board authorizes the administration in each school building to issue a school calendar based on the district calendar and in accordance with the required number of days (hours) adopted by the Board.

All calendars shall include the dates for all staff inservice programs scheduled for the coming school year.

A copy of the calendar shall be provided or made available to all parents/guardians of students enrolled in district schools. Any change in the calendar except for emergency closings or other unforeseen circumstances shall be preceded by adequate and timely notice of no less than 30 days.
