

Flag Displays

The superintendent or building principal shall see that the United States flag is prominently and permanently displayed in each academic classroom when classes are in session.

Except during inclement weather, whenever school is in session the United States and Colorado flags will be displayed on a flagpole on the administration building or grounds, and the United States flag will be displayed on a flagpole on each school's main building or grounds.

In accordance with C.R.S. § 22-32-109(1)(ii), the district will ensure that the right of school district employees and students to display reasonably the flag of the United States shall not be infringed with respect to the display on an individual's person, or on an individual's personal property or property that is under the temporary control of an employee or a student.

The district will observe traditional customs and practices of displaying the flags of the United States and of Colorado. Flags will be handled with respect at all times.
