

## School Attendance Areas

The School District is divided into various neighborhood attendance areas. The superintendent, with Board approval determines attendance area boundaries.

In establishing attendance area boundaries, consideration shall be given to the densities of students in an area in relation to the relative capacities of the schools, the equalization of enrollments in classrooms and efficient use of transportation facilities.

Attendance area boundaries shall be reviewed annually by the Superintendent or designee to determine if adjustments are needed to respond to housing and/or educational program requirements. Potential boundary changes shall be discussed with principals, citizen advisory committees and parents.
