

Entrance Age

Any child who will reach the age of five on or before October 1st shall be eligible to attend Kindergarten beginning in August of that year provided that proof of age is furnished at registration. Any child entering public school for the first time who will reach the age of six on or before October 1st shall be eligible to attend first grade beginning in August of that year provided that proof of age is furnished at registration.

For purposes of eligibility to attend school in the district, proof of age shall consist of any of the following:

1. Birth Certificate
2. Baptismal Certificate
3. A signed notarized statement as to the child's birth date.
4. Any verifiable indicator of proof deemed appropriate by the building administrator.

Students who do not meet the minimum age requirements for kindergarten or first grade shall not be admitted.
