

School Admissions

All persons aged 5 to 21 who reside within the boundaries of this school district may be permitted to attend school without payment of tuition. In addition, persons who do not reside in the district may be admitted under Board policies relating to nonresident students or by specific action of the Board.

New students entering from public schools and private schools accredited by the Colorado Department of Education shall be placed in grades and classes on the basis of their grade placement/credits in the school from which they are transferring.

The district administration, through academic achievement tests and other evaluation measures as found necessary, shall determine the appropriate grade level/credit status of students transferring from a non-public home-based educational program or a private school that has not been accredited by the Colorado Department of Education.

A birth certificate or other proof of legal age, as well as proof of residence, may be required by the school administration.
