

No Child Left Behind Requirements under Federal Law

Teacher Qualifications:

Federal Laws have created higher standards for teacher qualifications in public schools across the United States. The US Department of Education now defines minimum standards for the education and licensing of teachers and requires that local school districts work to insure that all teachers in core subject areas meet the definition of “highly qualified.”

Mapleton teachers already largely meet or exceed the federal requirements. However, all parents of children attending school districts receiving federal aid (Title I funding) have the right to know the professional qualifications of the classroom teachers who instruct their children. The school district is required to provide this information to you in a timely manner.
